

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter provided conclusions and suggestions from the description and discussion of the results presented in the previous chapter.

#### 5.1 Conclusion

Based on the data collection and discussion in the previous chapter, the researcher concluded that the students of the fifth semester of English department produced sentences with the correct rules of tense in their writing. From the data collection and analysis results, the final assignment produced by students most of them produced sentences in simple present and simple past. They paid attention to verb changes and also knew the rules in tenses, this statement was supported by data which showed 48,64 % of students produced sentences of simple present. Then, students also produced sentences on other types of tenses. They were like 45,96% of students produced sentences in the simple past, 5,4% simple future, and 0% other tenses. From this data, the researcher could find out that students in fifth semester have paid attention about using tenses in their final assignment. They were confused if using tenses applied in method section.

#### 5.2 Suggestions

This suggestion introduced several suggestions that were expected to provide more awareness in the learning process, especially in writing.

### 5.2.1 For Lecturer or teaching academic writing

The lecturer of academic writing especially in research method subject paid attention to the use of tenses. Thus, many students used present tense. The rules of their sentences are correct. However, method section used past tense. The researcher hoped the lecturer explained not only the structure in their article but also the tense used on every part in their article.

### 5.2.2 For students

The students of academic writing especially in reseach method subject paid attention in their tenses. They produced all sentece in the correct rules. However, they forgot the rule of method section. The researcher hoped the students paid attention on tense used in their article.

### 5.2.3 For other researchers

The result of this study were expected to provide informative knowledge about tenses with analysis of sentences. The result of this study was expected to be used for other researchers to attend research related to past tenses analysis to be a reference in their research. The researcher hoped to other researchers used more object than this research.
