CHAPTER IV


FINDING AND DISCUSSION

In this chapter, the results of research on speech acts presented about Illocutionary Acts of Donald Trump speech text. Based on the statement of the problems stated in chapter one, they were 1) What types of illocutionary acts are used by Donald Trump's campaign speech texts in the White House, USA? and 2) What functional of illocutionary acts are used by Donald Trump's campaign speech text in the White House, USA? the writer gave the following steps of analysis.

It consists of two parts, that is finding and discussion. The finding part present the data in table. And the discussion part show the explanation of the data in the finding part.

4.1 Research Findings

This research was conducted by researcher and contained a research question that focused on the types and functions of Donald Trump's campaign speech text in the White House. 

Based on the table 4.1.1 above, it can be seen that the Assertive/Representative of illocutionary acts amount to 32 data. Directive of illocutionary acts amount to 4 data. Commissive of illocutionary acts amount to 8 data. Expressive of illocutionary acts amount to 9 data. And Declarative of illocutionary acts amount to only 3 data.



4.3.2 Graph Functions of Illocutionary Acts

Based on the table 4.2 above, it can be seen that the functions of illocutionary acts are Competitive, Convivial, Collaborative, and Conflictive. Competitive of illocutionary acts amount to 7 data. Convivial of illocutionary acts amount to 9 data. Collaborative of illocutionary acts amount to 34 data. And Conflictive of illocutionary acts amount to only 6 data.

4.2 DISCUSSION

The discussion part present the deep explanation about the research finding in this research. This research discusses about the types and functions on illocutionary speech acts of Donald Trump's speech text in the White House, USA. In this discussion, the types and functions of illocutionary speech acts will be described clear and detail to answer of the statements of the problems.

4.2.1 The types on Illocutionary Acts of Donald Trump's Speech Text4.2.1.1 Assertive/Representative equal to 57%

Assertive/representative are speech acts forms that speakers to the truth being expressed, for example stating, suggesting, complaining, and claiming (Searle in Rahardi, 2005:36). The forms of assertive/representative speech acts in Donald Trump's speech text inW the White House are as follows:

In the United States, it has begun the most aggressive deployment since World War II.

(**Datum** #4)

Despite the fact that China has suspended domestic flights and protected its citizens in their home, China has banned them from entering my country.

(Datum #12)

China's carbon emissions are almost double that of the US, and are increasing rapidly.

(*Datum #17*)

Israel, the United Arab Emirates and Bahrain have all ruined historic history at the White House, with many other Middle Eastern countries to come.

(Datum #37)

As President, I have resisted failed approaches in the past, and Iam proud to put America first, just as you have to uphold your country. It's okay, that's all you have to do.

(*Datum #52*)

We have struggled a fierce fight against the virus of China, an invisible enemy that has claimed countless subsists in 188 countries.

(Datum #3)

The sentences above are the examples of assertive/representative named stating. The sentences named as stating because the sentences said by Donald Trump contains a statement for an information to others.

The next types of assertive/representative named claiming. The meaning of claiming is state a fact or the truth of something. Some examples of claiming in the Donald Trump's speech text are explained below:

A PENDIDIKAW TINGGI Instead, after the unilateral Paris Climate Agreement, I decided to reduce America's carbon emissions last year by more than one country.

(Datum #18)

They just want America, and I'm not going to support it.

(Datum #20)

Our army has increased significantly in size.

VAVASAN PEMAINALE

(Datum #27)

We stood for decades on China's trade abuses.

(Datum #29)

We are now stronger than ever.

(Datum #47)

4.2.1.2 Directive equal to 7%

This types tries the listener to do something, the speaker produces several effects through the act of the listener to do something or the instruction from the speaker, for example, ordering, commanding, begging, requesting, advising, and recommending, (Searle in Rahardi, 2005:36). The types of directive named advising. The meaning of advising is advise that everyone should always be held accountable for their actions. Some examples of advising in the Donald Trump's speech text are explained below:

We must strive for a brighter future and be responsible for the country that spread this epidemic to the world: China.

(Datum #10)

But only when you take care of your own citizens will you find a real basis for cooperation.

(**Datum #51**)
